

Never again?

Mahmoud Ahmadinejad, the President of Iran, has a vision.

He denies the Holocaust and declares that Israel, the Jewish homeland, should be “wiped off the map.”

And Tehran has a plan to make this genocidal vision a reality—with an intensive program, violating international treaty obligations, that could place nuclear warheads on missiles aimed at Israel, and potentially at countries from Europe to Asia to Africa.

Today, as many nations and the UN observe Holocaust Remembrance Day, history’s lessons are fresh: We ignore threats of genocide at our collective peril.

If the words “Never again” have meaning, they must compel responsible governments to prevent Iran from converting menacing intentions into horrific deeds.
