Introduction

The American Jewish Committee, which was among the very first American voices to call on the U.S. government in 1991 to recognize the reestablishment of Ukrainian independence, and which played a key role last year in the successful graduation of Ukraine from the purview of the Jackson-Vanik Amendment, remains strongly committed to working with Ukrainian officials to strengthen the ties between Ukraine and the West.

Introduction, Cont'd.

As Ukraine moves toward becoming a Western-oriented, market-based democracy, it is hampered in this laudable goal by The Interregional Academy of Personnel Management (MAUP). MAUP's anti-Semitic stance goes against the fundamentals of this Westernizing effort. Led by MAUP's president, Georgy Tschokin, the university spreads anti-Semitism and xenophobia. Couched in a veneer of academic respectability, anti-Semitic themes are woven into much of MAUP's "research." This "research" claims, among other findings, that Jews are responsible for all of the great social ills in modern times. There have also been frequent allegations that MAUP has received financial support from outside Ukraine, including Iran and Libya.

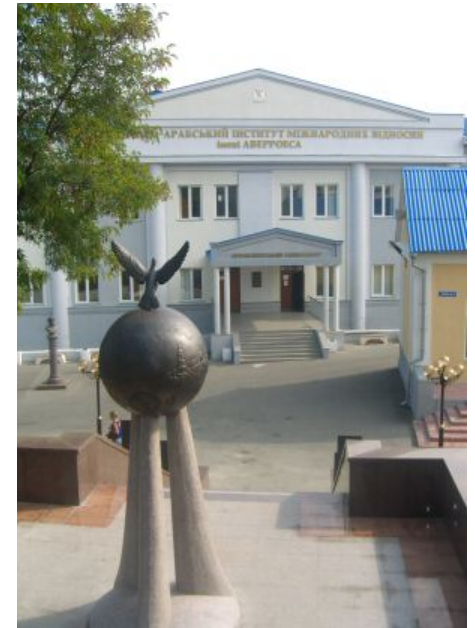
Make no mistake about it, MAUP plays a key role in Ukrainian society. It is not a marginal but a mainstream institution in Ukraine. Indeed, a number of Ukraine's top politicians have had connections with the university, though some, to their credit, have recently distanced themselves from the hatred and incitement spewed by it.

Profile of MAUP

The Interregional Academy of Personnel Management, MAUP

MAUP is a private higher education institution in Ukraine. Founded in 1989 as a non-state establishment, MAUP, with over 50,000 students, consists of a preparatory department, college, institutes, and a postgraduate school.

MAUP describes itself as the largest non-state higher education institution in Ukraine. It is accredited by the Ministry of Education of Ukraine to award degrees in ten higher education specialties, which are accepted nationally and internationally. UNESCO recognizes the MAUP university system as one of the world's high-level educational institutions. According to its website, MAUP has established centers in nine cities in surrounding countries including Prague, Czech Republic; Łódź, Poland; Moscow, Russia; Riga, Latvia; Minsk, Belarus; Tiraspol, Moldova; Chisinau, Moldova; Pernik, Bulgaria; and Baku, Azerbaijan. According to Josef Zissels, head of the Ukrainian Va'ad, a leading Jewish group, 70 percent of all anti-Semitic publications today come from MAUP, including "Mein Kampf" and "The Protocols of the Elders of Zion."¹

MAUP's President Georgy Tschokin

Georgy Vasilyevich Tschokin

Georgy Vasilyevich Tschokin, 51, is the founder and president of MAUP. He also established the International Management Academy (MKA), the international arm of MAUP.

Tschokin claims to be a scholar in the fields of management, psychology, sociology, and social philosophy. According to the MAUP website, Tschokin has received honorary doctorates from universities in “Azerbaijan, Belarus, Kirghizia [Kyrgyzstan], Moldova, Poland, USA, and other countries.”¹

In 2005, Tschokin attempted to enter into politics through a political party, Conservative Party of Ukraine. Thankfully, the party did not do well in the polls, which was a credit to the Ukrainian voters.

Tschokin is behind much of the anti-Semitic vitriol produced at MAUP.

He blames Jews for bringing about the demise of nationalism by introducing such concepts as “human rights” and “democratic values.”

“Today we have a new ideological center developing, called ‘Judeo-Liberalism’ — an artificial, inhuman ideology masquerading under messages of ‘humanism,’ ‘human rights,’ ‘social concern,’ and ‘democratic values.’ This movement will inevitably counter a healthy nationalism, one that is based on authentic faith, tradition, and love for the fatherland.”¹

In his keynote address at a MAUP conference in 2005, “Dialogue of Civilizations and the Fourth World War,” Tschokin accused Jews and their supporters of bringing on another world war.

“These people [Jews] are afraid of a broad and open discussion of their crimes and criminal plans. That is why a conference like this one must continue in order to warn the world about what is happening....

“These [the Jews’] actions also illustrate that there are those today who carry an ideology that threatens the entire world with hegemony and which is being enforced by permanent world war.”²

MAUP's President Georgy Tschokin

Tschokin uses the Conservative Party of Ukraine as another platform of anti-Semitism.

In a recent radio broadcast, Tschokin barely conceals his party's anti-Semitic platform.

“There were attempts to accuse us of stirring up ethnic and religious strife. Why? Perhaps because – according to published data- 45 per cent of the current composition of the Ukrainian parliament belong to a single ethnic group [the Jews], which amounts only to 0.2 percent of the Ukrainian population, or perhaps because all the richest men in Ukraine, who own all TV channels, financial and industrial companies are mainly representatives of the same ethnic group, as well as a great number of state officials, who - together with the above MPs [Members of Parliament] - have been managing Ukraine for the last 14 years.”¹

Tschokin also promised that his party, if elected, would spearhead the canonization process for Andrei Yuschinsky, a boy whose death in 1911 resulted in the trial of a Jewish man falsely accused of ritual murder.

While the Jew was acquitted of all charges against Yushinsky, MAUP's *Personal Plus* magazine fallaciously stated, “[Yuschinsky] was murdered by Jews with ritual purpose....[He] was sacrificed to dedicate the Chasidic Lubavitch central synagogue.”²

MAUP's President Georgy Tschokin

MAUP's president supported the Iranian president's call to destroy Israel.

On November 22, 2005, Tschokin issued the following statement of solidarity with Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad's threat to wipe out Israel:

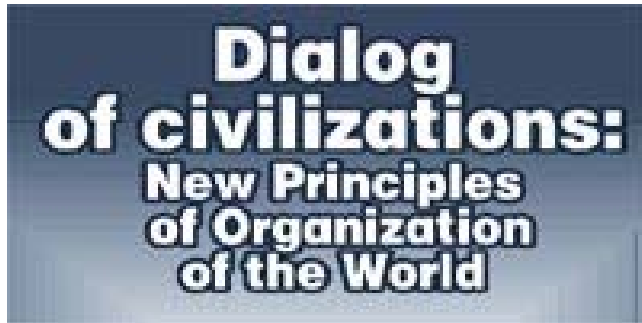
“We'd like to remind [you] that the Living God Jesus Christ said to Jews two thousand years ago: 'Your father is a devil!' . . . Israel, as [is] known, means Theologian, and Zionism in 1975 was acknowledged by [the] General Assembly of the UN as the form of racism and race discrimination, that, in the opinion of the absolute majority of modern Europeans, makes the most threat to modern civilization. Israel is the artificially created state (classic totalitarian type) which appeared on the political Earth map only in 1948, thanks to [the] good will of [the] UN. . . . Their end is known, and only the God's true [sic] will rescue all of us. We are not afraid, as God [is] always together with his children!”¹

Tschokin uses the university as another vehicle to spread his anti-Semitic rhetoric.



On the first page of MAUP's official website is a link to a paper (left), "Dialog [sic] of Civilizations." The eleven-page document outlines how Jews are responsible for most major political catastrophes from liberalism to Communism. The "research" is available in Ukrainian, Russian, English, Chinese, French, and Spanish languages to assure mass distribution and readership.

The following pages highlight a few verbatim quotes from this widely circulated publication.

Dialogue of Civilizations, Cont'd.

The “Dialog [sic] of Civilizations” finds that Jews believe they are racially superior, and this feeling of superiority explains why they have attempted to establish a global order.

“[C]onsequently, the idea of ‘a chosen nature’ and racial superiority of one people embedded in the old-time Judaic religion and still existing at the present day could, as many explorers believe, shove itself forward first through secret illegal societies of the type of international masonry, then, as the unlawful revolutionary movement inspired by itself grew, by means of the liberal or communist utopias, until, ultimately it was legalized in the form of international Zionism, the fruit of activities of which is represented currently by the now existing State of Israel – a permanent aggression source and security threat in the Middle East, and being aided and abetted by the USA, [sic] worldwide.”¹

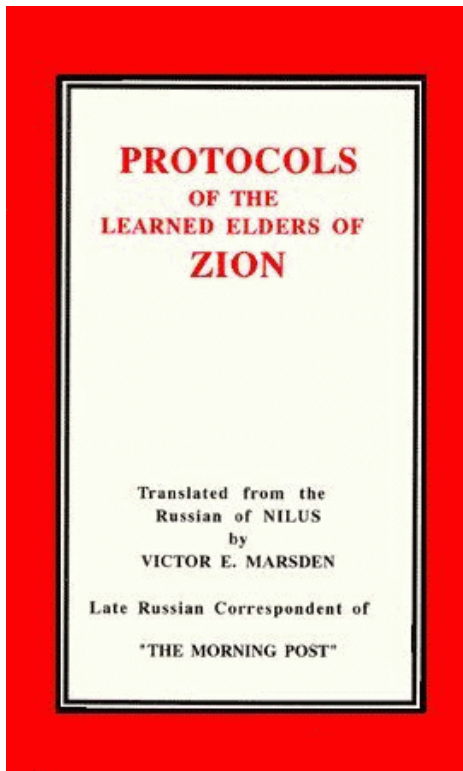

The article is steeped in language reflective of the infamous “Protocols of the Elders of Zion,” a forgery from the czarist period.



“[The Jews are responsible for the] creation, above all, of an extensive and multibranch network of secret societies coordinated from a single center and based on man-hating principles.

“[The Jews have a] concentration in their hands of thick financial flows, creation on their basis of large-scale (including international ones) financial structures capable to credit and to economically subordinate whole countries and regions, to fund (i.e., suborn) necessary political parties, as well as statesmen and public figures.

“[The Jews have] management of information flows due to concentration in their hands of mass media, book publishing, and book trade, which enables [them] to unimpededly manipulate the public opinion.”¹

Dialogue of Civilizations, Cont'd.

The “Dialog [sic] of Civilizations” denies Judaism as a world religion and calls for the destruction of Israel.

“The world religions (Buddhism, Christianity and Islam, the rest of religions are state-ethnic or tribal ones) represent the reference points of historical progress and the highest values of humanity.”¹

“UN member-states should initiate the repeal of this decision [UN General Assembly Resolution 181 creating the State of Israel] and liquidate the body politic in question [Israel].”²

“Personal” and “Personal Plus”

In addition to holding anti-Semitic conferences and producing anti-Semitic publications, MAUP also publishes two popular magazines “Personal” and “Personal Plus,” which further spread the anti-Semitic message.

Quotations from recent articles in *Personal*:

“The so-called ‘pogroms,’ despite the seeming harm to the Jews, in actuality always led to an even greater unity and wealth for the Jews. This is explained very easily with a psychological analysis. Following the nation’s explosion of wrath is an inevitable outpouring of sympathy and help to the victims.”¹

“Our grassroots movement, under the motto ‘to live without fear of the Jew,’ should be considered an important part of the Christian Orthodox religion’s effort to uncover our main enemy and to rid ourselves of fear of him. MAUP and David Duke

MAUP also attracts an international cadre of anti-Semitic “researchers,” including David Duke, a former KKK leader, who teaches at the university.

David Duke was a prominent Ku Klux Klan member from 1967 to 1978, after which he founded the National Association for the Advancement of White People.

In 2002, he received an honorary degree from MAUP, and in 2005, he received a full doctorate from MAUP for his paper entitled “Zionism is a Form of Ethnic Supremacism.”

Duke has made a career of Holocaust denial. He recently supported the Iranian president’s statements denying the Holocaust, saying, “The fact that a head of state has breached these issues ... is an incredible breakthrough for the cause of truth and freedom.”¹

Duke is not alone among Holocaust deniers in his close association with MAUP. A June 2005 anti-Zionist conference was attended by French Holocaust denier Serge Thion and Israel Shamir (a Russian Jew who converted to Christianity), both notorious anti-Zionists.

Conclusion – What Can Ukraine Do?

Ukraine's image as a Western-oriented, democratic, and tolerant nation is damaged by MAUP, which is by no means a marginal institution in Ukrainian society. While AJC applauds the recent decision by the Ukrainian Education Ministry to close seven regional campuses of MAUP for administrative reasons, further decisive action must be taken. Measures could include the following:

1. Invoke existing anti-incitement laws against Tschokin and those at MAUP who, through publications, conferences, and speeches, actively promote anti-Semitism or other forms of racial or religious hatred.
2. Review the process of licensing and accreditation of MAUP.
3. Examine sources of funding at MAUP, including repeated allegations that funds from the Middle East and elsewhere encourage the anti-Semitic vitriol.
4. Marginalize MAUP in Ukrainian society through ongoing forceful statements and decisive actions of respected Ukrainian leaders.
