AJC Cultivates New Allies for Israel

AJC helps strengthen and expand strategic alliances for the Jewish state.

- **Diplomatic Outreach:** With more than 30 offices worldwide, AJC meets regularly with top government officials from over 110 nations. At every encounter, we urge these leaders to form stronger ties with Israel and confront antisemitism masked as criticism of the Jewish state.
- **Forging New Paths Toward Peace:** Since 1994, AJC has quietly engaged with leaders throughout the Arab world in pursuit of regional peace and interfaith reconciliation. During countless visits to the region, AJC diligently encouraged greater contact with Israel. And in 2020, the signing of the Abraham Accords fulfilled a vision AJC sought for more than two decades.
- **Coalition-building:** AJC's pioneering interfaith and interethnic work encourages our partners in the Muslim, Christian, Black, Latino, and Asian communities to better understand Jewish concerns, including the Jewish connection to Israel.

AJC Promotes the U.S.-Israel Relationship

AJC marshals bipartisan backing for Israel across the United States in the face of intensifying political division.

- **Advancing Legislation:** Through our policy and political affairs department in Washington, D.C., and our 24 regional offices across the country, AJC has developed close working relationships with elected officials and other decision-makers. This has allowed us to be at the forefront of securing passage of laws that strengthen both Israel and the U.S.
- **Political Advocacy:** At the local, state, and federal levels, AJC works to ensure continued bipartisan support for U.S. aid to Israel, aims to defeat all attempts to condition aid, and continues to build the special U.S.-Israel partnership.

AJC Works to Make Israel Safer

AJC counters assaults to the Jewish state's right to exist in peace and security.

- **Beating Back Terror:** Within the international community, AJC advances the fight against anti-Israel terror and extremism. Through our network of overseas offices, AJC has taken on Hamas, Hezbollah, and Iran, and has inflicted serious political and legislative setbacks on all three.
- **Battling BDS:** The antisemitic boycott, divestment, and sanctions (BDS) movement seeks Israel's destruction as a Jewish state and AJC combats BDS at all levels. AJC advocates for anti-BDS legislation, rallies government officials to condemn BDS, and exposes the lies of the boycott Israel movement on a global scale.

AJC Fosters Truth and Dispels Lies About Israel

AJC works to inform the world about the *real* Israel: its challenges, accomplishments, and quest for peace.

- **Countering Misinformation:** AJC leverages our global media presence to publicly call out elected officials, news outlets, celebrities, and others in positions of power who disseminate anti-Israel—and often antisemitic—propaganda and lies.
- **Spreading the Facts:** With the largest social media following of any Jewish organization, AJC is able to quickly give millions of people swift access to the information they need to understand and respond to events relating to Israel.
- **Opening Minds:** Through Project Interchange (PI), AJC brings influential figures to Israel to experience the Jewish state first-hand. To date, 6,000 leaders, including diplomats, university administrators, and journalists, have participated. After seeing how the reality differs from popular narrative, 90% of PI alumni later speak out to set the record straight.

AJC Educates the Next Generation on Israel

AJC has built unique leadership programs that empower young people to stand up for Israel and world Jewry.

- **High School:** Leaders for Tomorrow (LFT) trains high school students to be capable pro-Israel advocates now and when they get to college.
- **On Campus:** AJC prepares college students to establish campus alliances and better respond to antisemitic incidents and anti-Israel boycott resolutions.
- **Young Professionals:** AJC ACCESS gives Jewish leaders in their 20s and 30s a platform to advocate for Israel and the Jewish people in their local communities and on the global stage.
