

How **Corporations** Can Address Rising Antisemitism

All corporations can implement measures to better understand, respond to, and prevent anti-Jewish hatred in our society. *AJC's Call to Action Against Antisemitism: A Society-Wide Nonpartisan Guide for America* calls on corporations to take the following steps:

- ☐ Adopt a clear, zero-tolerance policy for antisemitism in the company
- ☐ Regularly engage with Jewish employees and include Jewish people in trainings and company communications on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)
- ☐ When an antisemitic incident occurs, the CEO and senior leadership should unambiguously, unequivocally, and specifically call it out, internally and/or externally
