How Corporations Can Address Rising Antisemitism

All corporations can implement measures to better understand, respond to, and prevent anti-Jewish hatred in our society. AJC's Call to Action Against Antisemitism: A Society-Wide Nonpartisan Guide for America calls on corporations to take the following steps:

Adopt a clear, zero-tolerance policy for antisemitism in the company

Regularly engage with Jewish employees and include Jewish people in trainings and company communications on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)

When an antisemitic incident occurs, the CEO and senior leadership should unambiguously, unequivocally, and specifically call it out, internally and/or externally
