

How Local, State, and Federal Law Enforcement Can Address Rising Antisemitism

All law enforcement can implement measures to better understand, respond to, and prevent anti-Jewish hatred in our society. *AJC's Call to Action Against Antisemitism: A Society-Wide Nonpartisan Guide for America* calls on law enforcement to take the following steps:

- ☐ Report hate crime data using the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) to collect and share more accurate data with the FBI
- ☐ Train incoming recruits and current personnel on antisemitism
