State of Antisemitism in America 2023 Report

American Jewish Committee's annual [State of Antisemitism in America 2023 Report](#) assesses and compares Jewish and general population perceptions of and experiences with antisemitism in the United States. Based on one of the largest-ever combined national surveys of American Jews and the U.S. general public, the report demonstrates the deeply disturbing impact that rising hatred of Jews has on America's Jewish community. The survey was conducted in Fall of 2023, shortly after the October 7th massacre against Israel by Hamas, the deadliest attack against Jews since the Holocaust. AJC's Antisemitism Report addresses feelings of Jewish insecurity in America in 2023, including in a post 10/7 world.
