THE STATE OF ANTISEMITISM IN AMERICA 2023

The following is a breakdown of key findings from the parallel surveys comprising AJC's *State of Antisemitism in America 2023 Report*, shown for various audiences in comparison to the national average. The below demographic breakdowns from the Survey of American Jews consist of the responses from 213 Jews ages 18-29, and 1,313 Jews over age 30. The Survey of U.S. Adults polls 245 adults ages 18-29, and 968 adults over age 30. The margin of error for the Survey of American Jews is +/- 3.2% at the 95% confidence level, and the margin of error for the Survey of U.S. adults is +/- 3.9% at the 95% confidence level. The margin of error for the below disaggregated groups will be larger.
